  2. **Fall Fundraiser** – Rene Rosiak reported that over \$42,000.00 worth of items were sold during the Fall Fundraiser. An exact total for profit will soon be reported. Tressa Tucker was the Top Seller with 106 items sold. Fifty students will be participating in the Limo Lunch and 64 students will receive VIP plus seating for the Magic Show. Pick up for Fundraiser Items will be on October 25<sup>th</sup> from 3:00 – 5:30. Please consider helping out if you available. The truck will be at Armstrong for delivery or items at 1:00pm that day, we are still looking for volunteers to help with unloading. Again, contact Rene is you can help.
